Dear John Reigert:

This is in response to your letter to the Board requesting that your complaint against Mark Barcelo be reopened.

Please understand that we carefully reviewed all the information you originally submitted to arrive at the decision to close your complaint without the initiation of formal disciplinary action. Following receipt of your request to reopen the complaint, the entire file and the additional information that you sent to the Board were reexamined; and it was again determined that the case should, in fact, be closed because there was not sufficient basis to support formal disciplinary action by this agency.

In cases that are closed without the initiation of formal disciplinary action, the Secretary and Supervising Member may have taken other steps to ensure that the practitioner's future practice is in compliance with the requirement of the Medical Practices Act. Those other steps, however, would be part of the confidential investigatory process, and would not be subject to disclosure.

Although your complaint was closed without the initiation of formal disciplinary action, please be assured that it remains on file permanently with the Board, and will be taken into consideration if further complaints are received on this licensee.
